

Can-SOLVE CKD Network

A BC team is co-leading Canada's largest-ever effort to improve care for people with kidney disease. The Can-SOLVE CKD Network (Canadians Seeking Solutions and Innovations to Overcome Chronic Kidney Disease) is focused on reducing the number of people who need dialysis or organ transplants, and who develop serious kidney-related illnesses.

The five-year, \$40.4 million initiative is targeted at three areas for improvement:

1. Early identification of kidney disease;
2. Determining the best course of treatment;
3. Ensuring delivery of the best patient care.

Indigenous communities are a particular area of focus, given the high risk for kidney disease among Indigenous peoples in Canada.
